

Shotgun

Little River Sporting Clays is located at the SSAA range Eagle Park.

The Club shoots twice a month. The second Sunday each month (excluding January and December) is a practice day, and we cater for people who would like to try the sport, to see if they like it before the expense of purchasing equipment.

A target is set for beginners away from the practice ground and tuition is supplied. The cost for this is \$25 which includes ammunition, clays, use of shotgun, and coaching.

Practice is set in the form of a 5 stand competition with targets similar to the targets shot in competition, and is good practice for competition days. The cost of a round at practice is \$8 for 25 targets and \$9 per box of ammunition if needed. Most shooters bring their own ammunition. We have a small quantity for sale if required. No canteen facility is available on the shotgun ground on practice days, a Café is on the main range Saturday and Sunday each weekend.

The fourth Sunday is a 75 target sporting clay layout set for competition. The targets are arranged over 10 grounds and set similar to simulated field. Six shooters in each squad. Nominations start at 9am and close at 11am. The cost for 75 targets is \$36. All shotgun shooters are welcome. A canteen facility is available for competition days.
