## How to Get There

Getting to the Sydney Showground for the SHOT Expo is easy. Public transport is plentiful with lots of trains and buses that drop you off right at the entrance of the Showground. Please note that weekend timetables will apply during the SHOT Expo.

**Trains** - Every 20 minutes between Lidcombe and Olympic Park Station.

**Buses** - Route 525 from Parramatta and Strathfield stations every 30 minutes on Saturday and every 60 minutes on Sunday. Route 401 will leave from Church Street, Lidcombe every 60 minutes on Saturday and it will be running only from Sydney Olympic Park wharf on Sunday.

**Ferry** - Parramatta River Cat from Circular Quay to Sydney Olympic Park Wharf every 60 minutes and connecting with the 401 bus to the Showground.

**Parking** - a major car park is located just across the road from Hall 4 at P6F. Parking costs \$4 per hour to a maximum of \$20 per day, with meters taking coins, notes and credit cards.

Pensioner concessions - \$10

Kids under 15 – Free when accompanied by an adult
