### **Terms and conditions – SSAA SHOT Expo e-newsletter giveaway**

#### **General**

2. Information on how to enter and prizes forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. To the extent of any inconsistency between these terms and conditions and any other reference to this competition, these terms and conditions prevail.

#### **Who can enter**

4. Any member of SSAA Victoria.
5. Any winner under the age of 18 must obtain written consent via email or posted letter from a parent or guardian before the prize will be posted. If permission is not obtained within two weeks, the prize will be forfeited.
6. The Promoter reserves the right to request winners to provide proof of identity and proof of entry validity in order to claim a prize. In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.

#### **When to enter**

7. The competition commences on Wednesday, April 12, when the e-news alert is sent to the members and concludes at 5pm on Thursday, April 13 AEST. Entries must be received by the Promoter prior to the competition close date and time.

The author of the five entries deemed by the promoter as most creative will win a double pass each. The cost of accessing the promotional website will be dependent on the entrant's individual internet service provider.

10. Any entry with body text (entry excluding contact details) containing more than 150 words will be disqualified.

11. Any entry that is made on behalf of an entrant by a third party will be invalid.
